### **WINTER SPORTS TRYOUT PASSES**

During the week of November 8th, athletes who are playing a winter sport will need to get a tryout pass. Coaches will not allow students to tryout unless they have a pass. In order to get a pass, the following need to be turned in:

- Minnesota State High School League form (one per school year),
- a current physical (within the last 3 years) on file at school,
- the \$100 athletic fee (Fee will be returned if player does not make a team.),
- fall sport equipment must be turned in.

**If your son or daughter needs a new physical, please schedule the doctor appointment before November 8th.** Athletes who played a fall sport have their forms turned in. The only thing they need to turn in is the athletic fee.

The wrestling and boys hockey fees will be paid up front at the time of tryout passes. No other bill will be sent. The wrestling fee is \$200 and the boy's hockey fee is \$800. These fees are in place of the regular athletic fee for wrestling and hockey. Fees will be returned if a player does not make a team.
