## TUITION POLICIES

Families are provided with the following four options for paying tuition through TADS:

**One-Time Payment.** Pay tuition and fees in one lump sum by July 15, 2025, and receive a 2% discount on the tuition portion (\$283 for non-association congregation students and \$269 for association congregation students). If paid by credit card, there is no discount. Discount does not apply for international tuition.

**Semi-Annual Payment.** Pay half of the tuition and fees in August 2025, and then pay the second half of tuition and fees in January 2026.

**12 Monthly Payments through TADS.** Pay tuition and fees in 12 equal monthly payments by automatic withdrawal through TADS. Payments for 2025-2026 are paid from June 2025 through May 2026.

**10 Monthly Payments through TADS.** Pay tuition and fees in 10 equal monthly payments by automatic withdrawal through TADS. Payments for 2025-2026 are paid from August 2025 through May 2026.

## STUDENT CLASS FEES

## ATHLETIC FEES

Concordia Academy currently assesses a fee of \$200 per athlete per sport, with a limit of \$400 in fees for each athlete. Fees for co-op sports such as hockey and wrestling are assessed separately as those programs are funded in cooperation with other schools. If a student tries out but does not make the roster for a team, the fee will be returned.
